#### **Maude Slept Here**

The Western Railway Museum, located off Highway 20 between Fairfield and Rio Vista, is home to a collection of authentic historic streetcars and interurban electric trains from all over California and the western U.S. Visitors can take an electric train trip through the peaceful, picturesque Montezuma Hills over the original main line of the Sacramento Northern Railway. The railcar home of Maude (Ruth Gordon) from the cult movie *Harold and Maude* is located at the Western Railway Museum.

#### **Clint Eastwood Made a Stop Here**

Not far from the Western Railway Museum, head over to Birds Landing. At the corner of Collinsville and Birds Landing roads, the ramshackle “Tavern” is where Clint Eastwood filmed portions of *Honkytonk Man* in 1982. A sign on the side of the building proudly displays its movie moniker of “Myrtle’s Diner.”

#### **Can You Say Sue Soon?**

Suisun (pronounced SUE-soon) means “west wind” in Patwin, the Native American tribe that once inhabited this area. As names go, Suisun is very popular in this neck of the woods. You’ll find a city, a valley and a marsh bearing the name.
